\$1,000 Student Scholarship + \$500 School Award

Juniors/Seniors, submit an essay on one of the following topics:

- Discuss the Role of Nuclear Energy in Providing Electricity to the 2 Billion People Worldwide Who Need It, Without Increasing CO² Emissions.
- Discuss the Expanding Role of Different Isotopes in Nuclear Medicine. Please include the importance of both isotope origin and ensuring an adequate, stable supply.
- Describe How Japan Compensated for Shutting Down Their Nuclear Power Plants After the Earthquake and Tsunami in March 2011. Please address the technology choices for producing replacement power, their economic comparisons to nuclear generated power, and the overall impact on Japan's economy.

Criteria:

- Open to high school **juniors** or **seniors** attending school in Aiken, Allendale, Barnwell, Columbia or Richmond Counties in SC & GA
- Open to CNTA members' family who are high school **juniors** or **seniors** regardless of school location
- 1,000 – 1,500 word essay
- Proper citation of sources is required
- One submittal per contestant
- **Electronic submittals are preferred (no faxes will be accepted)**
